Parking

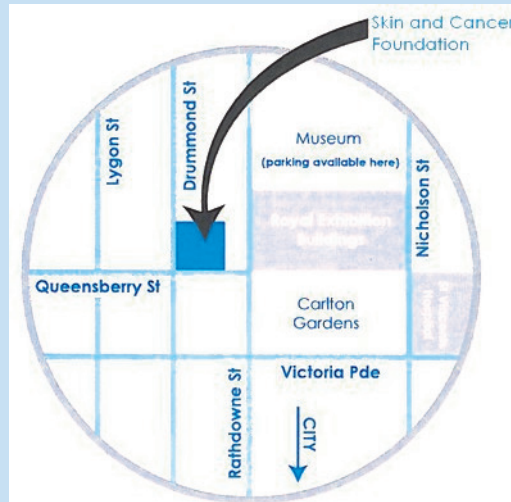
There is metered parking available in the streets close by. Also there are 24 hour public parking garages off Pelham and Rathdowne Streets

Anti-Wrinkle Injectibles

Wrinkles happen – why? Both excessive sun exposure and repeated contractions of facial muscles produce frown lines or the 'crows feet effect' around the eyes. Expertly placed injections of anti-wrinkle treatments (*Botulinum toxin*) temporarily relax the local muscle(s) causing the lines to reduce over time providing a natural look. The effect lasts for 3 – 6 months and treatments may be repeated to sustain the benefit.

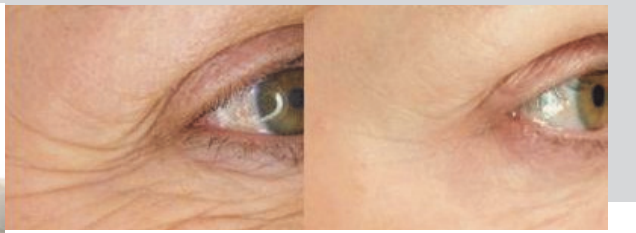
The use of Botulinum toxin injectibles has been proven clinically to be beneficial in treatment of conditions such as Hyperhidrosis (excessive sweating). Ask your dermatologist if you suffer from this condition.

Fillers & other Injectibles

Dermatologists may recommend and use fillers for treating some wrinkles, scarring or hollows to give your skin a smoother appearance.

Our expert consultants will assess and determine the most appropriate treatment to suit your individual condition and skin type. Additional treatments may be required to maintain a healthy appearance. Vascular laser treatment may be used as an alternative or complementing treatment, whilst other injectibles are used to treat unwanted dilated blood vessels or veins (e.g. varicose or spider veins). The solution injected results in fading or disappearance of the surface appearance of these veins or vessels.

Fillers are also an invaluable support in improving the appearance of expression lines, scarring and wrinkles. Providing volume to the treatment area including lips results in a fuller more youthful appearance.



Laser

The Foundation has acquired a suite of state of the art laser's supplied by global leaders in laser aesthetic solutions namely Candela and Solta.

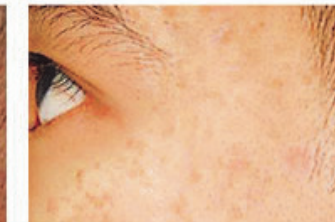
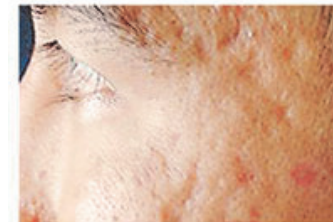
Laser therapy is used to restore skin, giving a more youthful appearance and treat a range of skin conditions including:

- Skin rejuvenation (pigmentation, skin tightening, wrinkle reduction)
- Pigmented lesions (sun/age spots, melasma)
- Vascular conditions (leg/facial veins, hemangiomas)
- Acne and surgical scarring
- Hair reduction

The number of treatments and length of time will depend on your individual skin condition, which will be assessed and discussed with you by one of our consultants on your initial visit.

The type of laser treatment used will also be dependent upon your individual skin requirements. The Foundation currently has a number of lasers including:
